Fukushima High School, designated as SSH (Super Science High School) by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, has been providing a leading-edge education in the field of natural science such as physics, biology and chemistry. The SS club continues students' voluntary activities. After the nuclear accident, a team called "Hoshasen-Han" (Radiation-Team) has been established within the club to study the conditions of Fukushima accurately. A study of dose comparison between inside and outside Fukushima through dose research with cooperation of 216 individuals in 12 areas inside and outside Japan was published in an authoritative academic journal and they were given the opportunities to make a presentation in an international conference and appear in a press conference hosted by the foreign correspondents club. After these activities, the club continued the research on the conditions of the area for which the evacuation order was lifted and on the decommissioning of the Fukushima Daiichi NP. Last November, the club members had an on-site observatory tour for the first time as high school students.
