

(Social Entrepreneurship Club, Futaba Future High School)

Opened in April 2015, Fukushima Prefectural Futaba Future High School adopts a cutting-edge curriculum which aims to overcome the various difficulties being faced after the nuclear disaster, and developing “reformers” who take on the role of building a new sustainable society. Along with the opening of the school itself, MEXT (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) also approved it as a Super Global High School. Centered on Problem-Based Learning (PBL), Futaba Future High School practices proactive and interactive deep learning, i.e. active learning, and investigational activities where all students seek to solve local problems. In addition, “Social Entrepreneurship Club”, as an extra-curricular activity, checks the safety of the living area by examining the local radiological conditions scientifically and delivers such information to both Japan and overseas countries.
