1. Objective

The Abstracts will be published online for the purpose of introducing the leading-edge technologies and R&D for the decommissioning of the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station.

2. Specification – Summary

- Summary of the Abstract.
- Up to 200 words (English).
- Input directly into the Poster Session registration system.

3. Specification – Abstract

- See attached template of Abstract.
- **Paper size:** A4(210mm x 297mm), 1 sheet
- **Language:** English
- **ID number:** Leave a blank space of 30mm x 15mm at the upper left corner. The Secretariat will fill in your ID number.
- **Margins:** 25mm for all four sides (top, bottom, left, and right)
- **Font:** Century, Times New Roman, Symbol are recommended.
- **Layout:** Place Title (13pt), Author names (11pt), Affiliations (11pt) and Abstract (10pt) at the top and References (9pt) at the bottom.

The Abstract section should provide a short summary of your presentation (approx. 60 words). There are no restrictions on the use of colors in your Abstract.

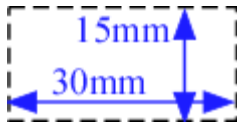
- **Submission:** Please convert your abstract data to PDF file and upload via Poster Session registration system. The PDF file must not exceed 3MB. You are not allowed to compress/password protect your PDF file or use any other security features.
- The secretariat will check the format of the data submitted only. Each presenter is responsible for the preparation of the presentation and any linguistic modifications.

2. Configuration of Page Layout

2-1. Length of the abstract

The abstract length is limited to 1 page of A4:210mm x 297mm. Please do not insert the page numbers in your abstract. The authors apply single column, and Top: 25mm, Bottom: 25mm, Left: 25mm, Right: 25mm as margins.

2-2. Font type

Century, Times New Roman and Symbol are recommended. The font should be embedded if you use other font types than these recommended.

2-3. Font sizes

1) Title/Subtitle: 13pt, 2) Author names: 11pt, 3) Affiliations: 11pt, 4) Abstract: 10pt, 5) Introduction to Conclusion: 10pt, 6) References: 9pt

2-4. Figures and Colors

The abstract may include tables, figures and captions. There are no restrictions on the use of colors in your abstract.

2-5. Points to consider when preparing PDF file

The PDF file must not exceed 3MB. You are not allowed to compress/password protect the file or use any other security features.

3. Conclusion

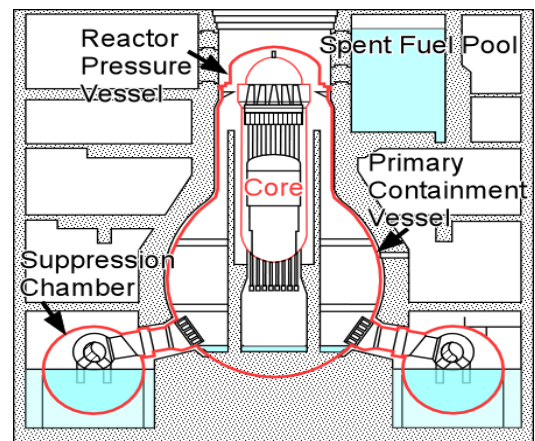


Figure 1. Cross section of BWR

1. Objective

The Poster will be presented at the 9th International Forum to introduce the leading-edge technologies and R&D for the decommissioning of the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station. The posters will be used for holding the session only.

2. Specification

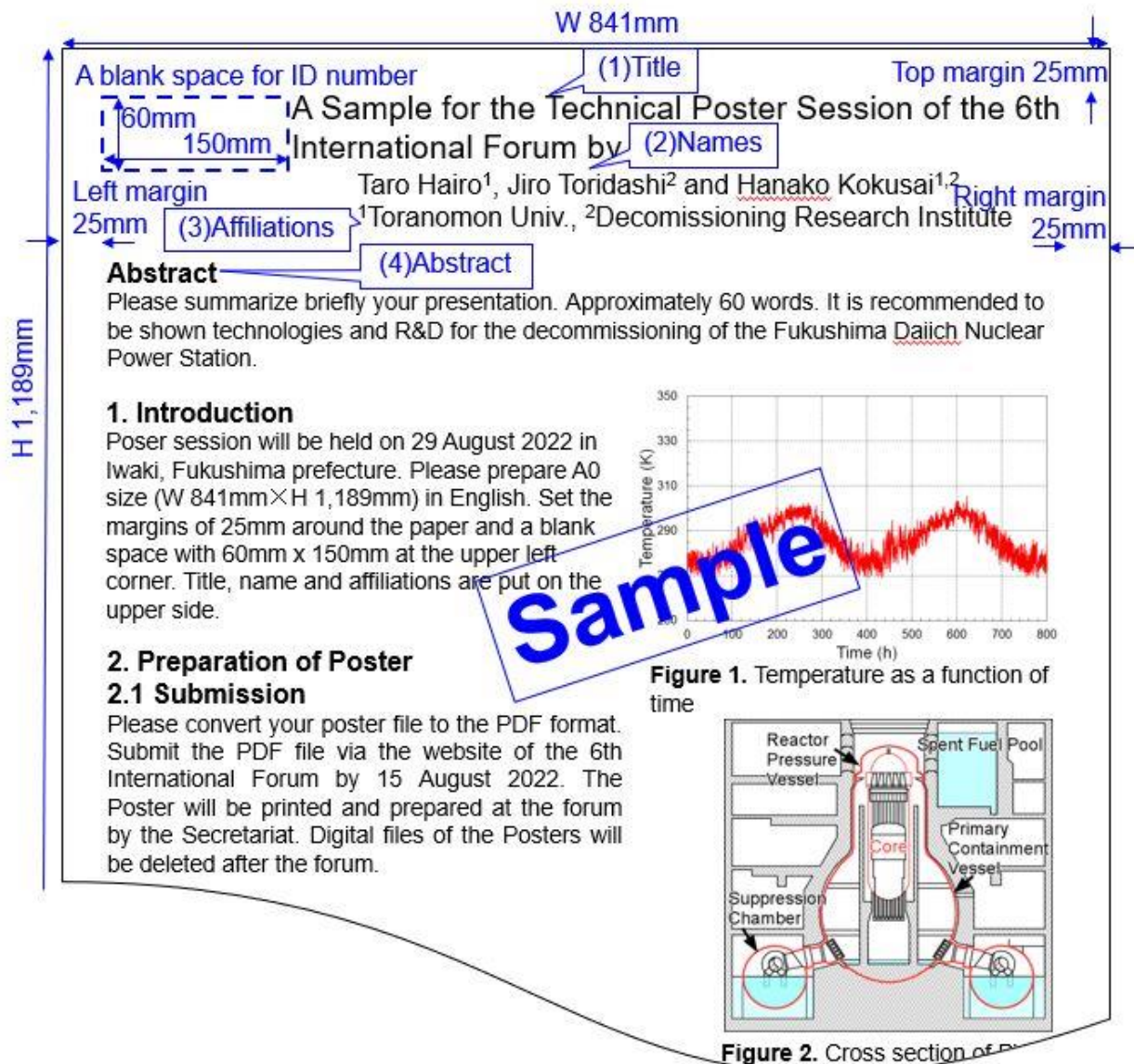


Figure 1 Conceptual illustration of Poster

- **Poster size:** Portrait A0(W 841mm x H 1,189mm), 1 sheet, See Figure 1.
- **Language:** English
- **ID number:** Leave a blank space of 60mm x 150mm at the upper left corner. The Secretariat will fill in your ID number.
- **Margins:** 25mm for all four sides (top, bottom, left, and right)
- **Layout:** Place Title, Author names, Affiliations and Abstract prominently at the top of the poster.

The Abstract should provide a short summary of your presentation (approx. 60 words).

- **Colors:** There are no restrictions on the use of colors in your poster.
- **Font/Size:** Please choose a font which is easy to read. It is also important to choose a suitable font size.
- **Submission:** Please convert your abstract data to PDF file and upload via Poster Session registration system.

You are not allowed to compress/password protect your PDF file or use any other security features.

- The posters will be printed and prepared at the venue by the Secretariat.
- The digital files of posters will be deleted after the forum.
- The secretariat will check the format of the data submitted only. Each presenter is responsible for the preparation of the presentation and any linguistic modifications.

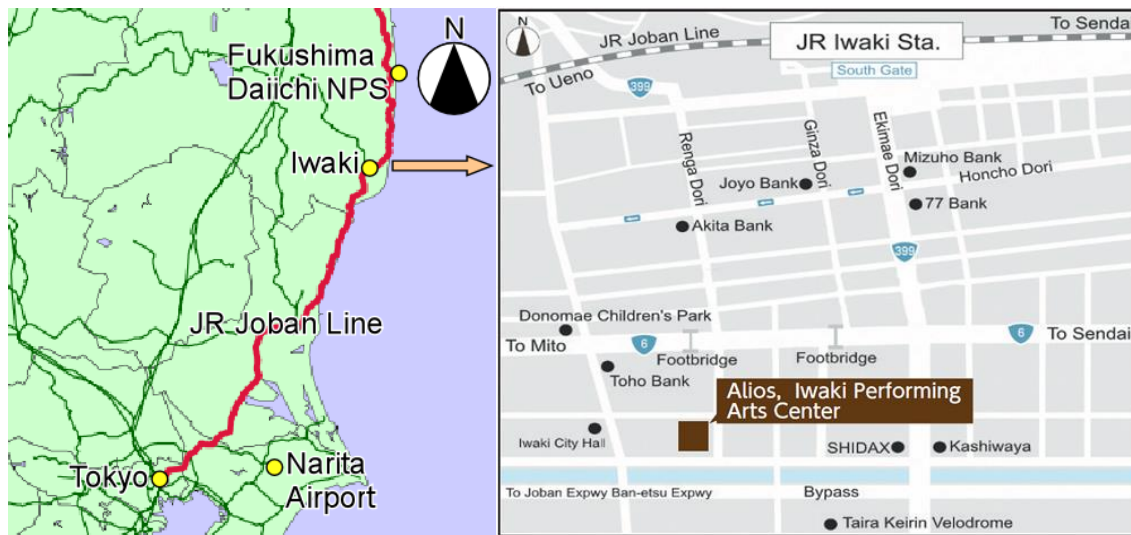
4. Other showpieces
