国会議員政策担当秘書として外交安全保障政策や教育政策に携わったのちに、一般社団法人リテラシー・ラボを設立。市民の社会参画を促すシティズンシップ教育や多様性向上のプロジェクトを東京都などで実施する他、福島県では東日本大震災と福島第一原子力発電所の事故によって避難を経験した地域の教育復興分野において、避難先と帰還後の教育環境に着目した活動と研究を行っている。2021年から福島大学に着任し、福島県浜通り地域(相双地域)において学生たちとフィールドワーク調査を実施し、地域住民らとの交流や対話を通じた教育活動を展開している。

Mr. Izaya Chiba previously served as the policy secretary of a Diet member, focusing on foreign and security policies as well as education policies. Subsequently, he founded Literacy Lab, a general incorporated association that provides citizenship education to promote citizens' social participation and organizes diversity enhancement projects in Tokyo while, in Fukushima, implementing activities and research in the field of educational reconstruction focused on the educational environments at temporary living locations for evacuees and after their return to hometowns in the regions where residents were forced to evacuate in the aftermath of the Great East Japan Earthquake and the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station accident. Since 2021, he has assumed a post at Fukushima University, Conducting fieldwork research with students and engaging in educational activities through exchanges and conversations with local residents in the Hamadori area (Sousou area) of Fukushima Prefecture.
